## **BBQ PIT FELLOWSHIP GUIDELINES**

Please honor our Lord and fellow Christians by leaving the BBQ Pit nicer than you found it, and by following these guidelines:

- 1. Remove all trash from all the containers in the kitchen, restroom, and the outside areas & place in the commercial trash container outside by the bus barn.
- 2. Wash all dishes, knives, utensils, flatware, etc. and replace in cupboards and drawers.
- 3. Clean all counter tops and surfaces.
- 4. Clean and sanitize the restroom sink and toilet. Replenish paper towels and toilet tissue when needed.
- 5. Restock any paper products that you use.
- 6. Fold up chairs and tables and return them to their places.
- 7. Set the air to 80 degrees in the summer. Set the heat to 65 degrees in the winter. Do not turn off the HVAC unit, as this could damage the food and equipment stored here. Leave the ice machine on.
- 8. Sweep and mop the floor. Mop water should be dumped OUTSIDE, not in the kitchen sinks.
- 9. Refrigerators are for temporary use during your event times. Please remove leftover condiments, beverages & all food when you leave.
- 10. Turn off the lights and make certain all doors are locked, including the restroom door.

Nonmember deposits will be returned to you contingent upon these guidelines being followed and the facility inspected by our staff or Pit Foreman and found compliant.
